

**BBB tip: Don't lose money when trying to lose weight in the new year**

January 3, 2022-- The new year provides a fresh start for many consumers. Some may be thinking of losing the extra holiday weight, or making healthier choices in 2022. But, the desire to get in shape or lose weight fast creates a risk of being deceived by products that do not work as advertised. The Better Business Bureau Serving Western Michigan cautions consumers to avoid losing money when trying to lose weight.

“When you’re trying to lose weight, it’s not always easy to tell the difference between beneficial products/providers and scams. Don’t be a victim of clever marketing tricks that don’t deliver on actual results.” Says Lisa Frohnepfel, President & CEO of the Better Business Bureau Serving Western Michigan. “Save yourself the headache and keep your motivation on track by doing your research first with the BBB.”

Tips to avoid weight loss scams:

- Always be wary of advertisements and customer endorsements promising “miracle” results or immediate weight loss. There is no such thing as a “secret ingredient” or “breakthrough formula” that can result in weight loss virtually overnight. Be especially skeptical of claims that you don’t have to give up unhealthy foods or reduce the amount you consume. Note the typical weight loss is often significantly less than the testimonial shown in the advertisement.
- Research the company with BBB.org & BBB Scam Tracker before purchasing.

Read reviews about the company to see if there are any complaints alleging that it’s a scam.

- Check a product’s ingredients with the FDA. Be suspicious of taking special pills, powders or herbs. Some products have been recalled for containing ingredients with potentially dangerous effects. Check the list of public notifications from the FDA regarding potentially harmful weight loss products.
- A lack of an ingredients list is a red flag.
- Be wary of free trial offers and understand all the terms and conditions. These deals can become “subscription traps” that hook consumers into expensive shipments of products they did not agree to buy.

Another option to get healthy is joining a gym. However, don’t just sign up at the first gym you see. Get the most from a gym membership using these tips from BBB:

- Figure out your priorities. Will a convenient location and extended hours help you stick to your fitness plan? Will a variety of equipment or classes keep you motivated?
- Check BBB.org. Read what previous customers have to say, and see how the businesses respond to complaints. This information may help you narrow down the list of gyms you want to tour in person.
- Take a tour and ask questions. Gyms often give a one-week free pass for potential members. Take advantage of this to check out the gym at a time you would normally go. Make sure you understand all the rules. Ask about busy

times, wait times for equipment, whether classes require pre-registration, availability and cost of trainers, etc.

- Understand the terms. Read the contract carefully before signing. Make sure that all verbal promises made by the salesperson are in writing. What matters is the contract and the terms within it, so don’t just take a salesperson’s word for it. Will the membership renew automatically at the end of the term? What is the cancellation policy and under what circumstances?
- Calculate the true costs. Gyms often use special introductory offers to encourage new members, but the price could go up more than you budgeted once the initial period is over. Make sure you understand what the regular monthly fees will be and what they include.
- Don’t feel coerced. Do not give in to high-pressure sales tactics to join right away. A reputable gym will give you enough time to read the contract thoroughly, tour the facilities, do some research, and make an informed decision.

# \$5 million available to local governments for training and recruitment of first responders

LANSING, Mich. – Governor Gretchen Whitmer recently announced the launch of a \$5 million grant program to assist local governments in addressing critical needs in recruiting and training first responders.

"First responders are on the front lines of our health and our safety, and are always there for us when we need them the most," Governor Whitmer said. "We have to work together to put them first. We must find ways to recruit and train the next generation these real-life community heroes today so they can be there for us tomorrow. With these new grants, we can hire more law enforcement officers, firefighters, EMTs, paramedics, and local corrections officers to keep us all safe." As a part of the First Responder Training and Recruitment Grant Program, all Michigan cities, villages, town-

ships, counties or fire authorities are eligible to apply for a grant up to \$100,000 related to first responder training and recruitment. First responders are police officers, firefighters, Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs), paramedics and local unit of government corrections officers.

The purpose of the grant program is to support efforts of local governments to expand recruitment, improve training, and provide additional professional development and support to first responders in local governments.

Out of the \$5 million appropriated for the First Responder Training and Recruitment Grant Program, \$2 million has been designated for communities with a per capita property value of less than \$15,000.

Eligible communities applying for a grant must include in

their application the program purpose, demonstrating how budgeted costs directly relate to recruitment or training of first responders. Priority will be given to projects that will be completed by Sept. 30, 2022.

Applications must be submitted by Feb. 15, 2022.

"Michigan communities are prioritizing the recruitment and training of first responders," State Treasurer Rachael Eubanks said. "These dollars will help our communities provide better services to keep Michigan residents safe."

Applications will be selected for funding by the Michigan Department of Treasury based on program purpose, eligibility and criteria. Projects are funded on a reimbursement basis.

# How to protect teens in the age of social media

- Block unwanted apps and websites: Ensure your teen is only using apps and visiting sites that are approved by you. Using parental control apps to block apps, websites and contacts as needed can help you protect your child from unsafe people and content.

- Maintain open communication: The newly released

research draws links between social media usage and depression, anxiety and even suicidal thoughts. Be sure to regularly check in with your teen and keep the lines of communication open.

- Use new tools: New tech tools can help you get a handle on your teen's social media usage, as well as help you help them carve out healthy digital habits. For example, OurPact, a parental guidance app used by over 1 million families, allows you to create automated schedules for when internet and apps are unavailable, block access to the device for a specified period of time, whitelist and blacklist websites, and even take screenshots of digital activity. # HISTORICAL NOTEBOOK

by Frank Passic  
Albion Historian



## ALBION 100 YEARS AGO — JANUARY 1922

Happy New Year, everyone! We continue with our theme of "Albion, 100 Years Ago." January 3, 1922. "Major Harrison Soule, 89, for a quarter of a century treasurer of the University of Michigan, retiring in 1908, died at his home in Ann Arbor Monday. Major Soule was the son of Milo Soule, pioneer resident of Marengo Village."  
January 5, 1922. "Proposition Carries for New School.

The proposition put up to the voters of Albion School district for the sum of \$150,000 for the purpose of erecting the first unit of what will eventually be a complete high school building, was carried by a majority of 617 in favor, and 578 against. People came in swarms. Never before in the city's history have the people flocked to the polling place to settle a school matter as they did yesterday....A pool would

cost approximately \$25,000. A place in the new building will be reserved for the pool and it will be installed as soon as the necessary funds are at hand."

"Albion Office Sued for Damages. Papers were served last night by Deputy Sheriff G. U. McCarty on Office Albert Schwer, city night policeman, as the opening move in a suit for damages amounting to \$5,000 false imprisonment which was started in the circuit court yesterday afternoon by Charles Sprague, Dalrymple St. grocer."

January 6, 1922. "One hundred and fifty newly minted 1921 Peace Dollars were received at the Commercial & Savings Bank this morning. The design is a most pleasing relief from that of the dollars of recent years. [NOTE: A 1921 Peace Dollar in uncirculated condition today in 2022 is worth approximately \$500 because of its low mintage]"  
"The consolidated school district south of Albion finds

that its taxes are lower than any other part of Albion Township. This consolidated district is made up of the Babcock, King, South Albion, and Farley districts, and still maintains four separate schools. The district pays a thousand dollars or more in the way of tuition to Albion and Homer High Schools for older pupils who attend the city schools."

January 9, 1922. "Attorney Levi S. Warren, a well-known resident of this city, passed away at 7 o'clock Sunday evening at his home, 105 E. Oak St, age 77 years."

January 10, 1922. "New Company to Take Over Albion Mine. After weeks of negotiations, a deal has been consummated to make the coal properties north of this city one of the best equipped in the United States. Chicago and Milwaukee interests have been induced to make large investments here and to form a \$350,000 corporation known as the People's Coal Mining

Company, which will succeed the Albion Coal Mining Company."

January 12, 1922. "Albion College Gymnasium is Ruined by Fire. The Albion College gymnasium was practically destroyed by fire this morning...Chapel exercises at the college were just coming to a close when the fire broke out."

January 20, 1922. "Wills A. Litle becomes sole owner of the retail hardware business conducted on S. Superior St. under the name of Litle and Johnson. Litle and Johnson started their partnership in August 1921, when they bought the hardware stock of O. B. Granger in the present location."

January 25, 1922: "St. John's church is draped in black and purple, in common with all Catholic churches throughout the world, in memory of the late Pope Benedict XV, and the draperies will remain up until the Pope's funeral."

January 27, 1922: "Leon-

ard Hagerman, son of Frank Hagerman, Crandall St., underwent an operation for appendicitis in the city hospital last night, it being an emergency case. He is doing nicely."

"The people of the State of Michigan, by prosecuting attorney Cleary, began suit in the circuit court Thursday against N. Michlowicz of Albion to collect \$1,000 on a forfeited bond. Sam Lafer of Albion was arrested for violating the prohibition law and on May 28 he gave a \$1,000 bond signed by the above defendant for his appearance at the September term of court. He failed to show up at that time and the one following, thereby forfeiting the amount of the bond."

January 31, 1922: "Today is the 55th anniversary of the opening of the Howard Meat Market. George Howard, the original owner and proprietor, has always been active in the company."

Watermelon Chia Seed Muffins

**Watermelon Chia Seed Muffins**  
Yield: 12 muffins

- 1 can nonstick cooking spray
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1/3 cup sucralose
- 1 1/2 tablespoons lemon zest
- 2 cups flour
- 3/4 cup chia seeds
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 4 tablespoons canola oil
- 1/3 cup plain, nonfat Greek yogurt
- 3/4 cup liquefied watermelon juice
- 1/2 cup egg substitute
- 1 cup dried tart cherries
- 1 lemon, juice only
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 2 tablespoons sugar

Heat oven to 375 F. Spray 12-piece muffin pan with nonstick cooking spray.

In large bowl, combine sugar, sucralose and lemon zest. Use fingers to rub zest into sugar until fragrant. Add flour, chia seeds, baking soda, baking powder and salt; thoroughly mix. Set aside.

In medium bowl, whisk oil, yogurt, watermelon juice and egg substitute until thoroughly blended. Add cherries, lemon juice and vanilla.

Add liquid mixture to flour mixture. Gently toss until incorporated. Avoid overbeating or muffins will be flat and tough. Spoon evenly into muffin pan. Top each muffin with 1/2 teaspoon sugar.

Bake 15-17 minutes, or until toothpick inserted in middle comes out clean. Remove from oven, allow to sit 5 minutes then transfer muffins to cooling rack.



- 1-2 tablespoons chopped fresh mint


Place watermelon and onion in large bowl. Add balsamic vinegar and toss to combine. Add pistachios, feta and mint, reserving small amount of mint to sprinkle on top. Toss. Serve on large platter and sprinkle with remaining mint.




