OK2SAY helps community speak up for school safety

Kids are back in class, so now is a good opportunity for students, parents, teachers, and all of us to familiarize ourselves with the OK2SAY program — a key tool to help keep schools in our community safe. Administered by state police, OK2SAY is a statewide, confidential tip line that helps protect Michigan schools. Anyone can contact the system 24/7 to report possible crime or harm — including self-harm — directed at students, school employees, or schools. This vital program was created in 2013 to help alert officials about school-related danger by providing information about past incidents or warning about potential crises. By protecting the privacy of tipsters, OK2SAY makes it easier for people to speak up — confidently and confidentially.
 OK2SAY accepts tips through several different accessible contact points. People can submit tips by calling 855-

655-2729 (855-5-OK2SAY), texting 652729 (OK2SAY), emailing OK2SAY@mi.gov, visiting OK2SAY.state.mi.us online, or downloading the OK2SAY mobile app. Of course, emergencies should always be reported to 911.

After a tip is submitted, the OK2SAY team passes on necessary information to the authorities best equipped to respond to the situation. Primarily, that means schools or police, but incidents are sometimes referred to mental health services, on-line resources, counseling, crisis lines, or Children's Protective Services.
 The Michigan State Police recently published the annual OK2SAY report for 2021. Since 2014, OK2SAY has received a total of 32,947 tips. Last year, people submitted 6,255 tips, more than half of which came in December, following the tragic Oxford High School shooting. Whether to prevent another such attack, keep drugs and alcohol out of kids' hands, or get people care for their mental health, OK2SAY is here to help.
 A few years ago, my legislative colleagues and I unanimously approved a law to place information about the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline on the school ID cards of students at public middle and high schools. Each time they look at their IDs, young people are reminded that they can call 1-800-273-8255 for mental health support. This

critical resource is now known as the 988 Suicide and Crisis Lifeline, and anyone can call the Lifeline by dialing 988 or the full-length number. Building on that initiative, I strongly support a new plan to add OK2SAY contact information to student IDs, too. Kids should know how they can easily, confidentially report risks to their safety and well-being.

We absolutely must ensure the safety of Michigan students. The new, bipartisan education budget, which I helped approve in July, provides \$168 million for safety grants to Michigan schools, plus \$25 million specifically to support school resource officers. These law enforcement officers serve in our schools, getting to know students personally while maintaining security. As part of their duties, school resource officers play an important role in responding to some OK2SAY tips.

Because anyone can submit a tip about suspicious or malicious behavior, everyone in our Jackson community serves as extra eyes and ears for school officials and law enforcement. This school year, let's all be prepared to keep kids safe — knowing that when we see something, it's OK to say something.

What you need to know about heel pain

What is Plantar Fasciitis?

Plantar fasciitis is an inflammation of the band of tissue (the plantar fascia) that extends from the heel to the toes in which the fascia becomes irritated and then inflamed. Symptoms include pain on the bottom of the heel, pain in the arch of the foot, and swelling on the bottom of the heel. For many, the pain is worse upon arising and increases over a period of months.

A telltale sign of mechanical issues in the foot, those with overly flat feet or high-arched feet are more prone to developing plantar fasciitis. Lifestyle factors can also play a role. Wearing non-supportive footwear on hard, flat surfaces puts abnormal strain on the plantar fascia. This is particularly evident when one's job requires long hours on the feet. Obesity and overuse may also contribute to plantar fasciitis.

How is it Treated?

"We typically treat plantar fasciitis conservatively, at first," said Michael J. Cornelison, DPM, FACFAS, a foot and ankle surgeon and president of the American College of Foot and Ankle Surgeons. "This can include a combination of remedies, including rest, exercises

that stretch the calf muscles, orthotics, icing the heel, over-the-counter medications like ibuprofen, supportive footwear and physical therapy."

Most patients respond well to conservative treatments. However, depending on the severity of the plantar fasciitis, additional therapies may be required, including:

- Injection Therapy: Growth factor injections and platelet rich plasma injections are used to boost the body's healing response and help repair injured tissue.

- Shockwave Therapy: This in-office treatment uses sound waves delivered over the skin to slightly damage the tissue and stimulate the body's natural repair process. This helps the plantar fasciitis heal and relieves pain symptoms without making an incision. Patients can expect to be up and moving immediately after treatment, but it may take three to six months to see results.

- Ultrasonic Treatment: In this newer procedure, a small incision is made into the heel of the foot and a probe directs ultrasonic energy at the fascia to break down bad tissue and help the healing process. A diagnostic ultrasound tool is

used to create an image of the inside of the foot and guide the probe. Patients may need to wear a boot immediately after the procedure for up to two weeks and they can expect to see improvements anywhere from three to six months after the procedure.

- Surgery: Also called a plantar fasciotomy, this minimally invasive, minimally traumatic surgical treatment involves making a small incision through the heel into the damaged tendon to try to lengthen it and relieve tension. Patients tend to recover in six to 10 weeks, but it may take up to three months to resume exercise and more vigorous activities.

No matter what kind of treatment a patient undergoes, the underlying causes that led to the condition may remain. Preventive measures, such as wearing supportive shoes, stretching and using custom orthotic devices, are the mainstay of long-term treatment for plantar fasciitis.

- Divide each biscuit in half by pulling apart in centers. Use hands to flatten each biscuit into circles. Set aside.
- In bowl, mix mozzarella cheese with chopped jalapenos, bacon and salsa.

Add heaping spoonful into each flattened biscuit and pinch each together tightly to form balls. Top each with small amount of salsa mixture. Spray nonstick cooking spray in air fryer and, working in batches, cook biscuit bites 6-9 minutes until golden brown. Serve warm. HISTORICAL NOTEBOOK

ALBION 100 YEARS AGO, SEPTEMBER 1922

We continue with our theme of "Albion, 100 Years Ago." September 1, 1922. "Two Houses are Raided for Liquor. A liquor raid, staged about 3:30 Thursday afternoon...resulted in the arrest of two Mallory St. residents, a man and a woman, and the confiscation of considerable liquor and liquor-making paraphernalia. Those arrested were Wasel Okelatanto of 1209 Mallory St., and Mrs. Kate Zozulia of 1213 Mallory St.

September 6, 1922. "The Albion St. bridge was closed to traffic today by City Manager E. J. Mallory, until repairs can be made. The rods supporting the bridge have become rusted and have dropped several inches, making the structure unsafe on one side."

September 7, 1922. "2nd Infantry Encamped in Victory Park. Albion was visited

today for the second time this summer by a regular army detachment from Ft. Brady, Sault Ste. Marie. The outfit, the 2nd Infantry, formerly the 54th Infantry, was today returned to Brady from Camp Custer where about three months were spent on duty connected with the various citizens training camps just concluded."

"400 Methodist Pastors Will Invade City. Albion Methodists are working strenuously, in preparation for the entertainment here for one week of the nearly 400 ministers of the Michigan Conference who will gather here next Tuesday."

"Sam Daleo, son of Nick Daleo, local fruit merchant, had a badly smashed right thumb amputated below the first joint, at the city hospital Wednesday afternoon, and also had fractures set in the first and second fingers of

the same hand, the injuries resulting from an automobile accident occurring near Chelsea about 6 o'clock Wednesday morning."

September 8, 1922. "The Buddy Brooks Playground is the appellation by which a new playground for the boys of the Starr Commonwealth to be located on the western shore of Montcalm Lake between the Commonwealth buildings and the water-front, will be known. It is to be built and completely equipped through the generosity of Harold C. Brooks, well known citizen of Marshall., it was announced by Floyd Starr, head of the Commonwealth."

September 12, 1922. "But a short time after five men, identity unknown, abandoned a big Oakland touring car just west of Marengo on the Albion-Marshall pavement, the Willys "six" of Ignatz Ignachuk, 718 Austin Avenue, was stolen, about 8 o'clock last evening from in front of the Bijou Theatre, where it had been parked by its owner."

September 21, 1922. "The Willys touring car of Ignatz Egnatuk, which was stolen about a week ago, was located in Chicago yesterday. Chief of Police Clyde Stod-

dard received a letter this morning from the Chicago police department. It is expected that Mr. Egnatuk will go to Chicago today or tomorrow to claim his property."

September 22, 1922. "Airplane Will Photograph This City." What probably is the biggest photographic project ever attempted in the middle west began at Chicago today when one of the fleet of airplanes of the Diggins Aerial Photo Co. hopped off for a 2,000-mile flight over Michigan to make pictures of the cities served by the Consumers Power Co. and the big water power projects of the company in northern Michigan. The first day's itinerary includes Albion."

September 23, 1922. "Gale Mfg. Co. Makes Hospital Gift of \$500. A letter was received yesterday by the City Hospital board from M. T. Conklin of Detroit, president of the Gale Manufacturing Company, stating that the hospital

management will receive a gift of \$500 from the company with their good wishes for the new hospital enterprise.'

September 29, 1922. "The former Frank Wochholz residence has been moved by Charles Smith, for J. A. Richards, who purchased it recently from the city, from the

corner of River and S. Superior St., to S. Eaton St., at the end of Walnut St."

September 30, 1922. "The former Eslow homestead on W. Erie St., which was purchased by Walter Abbot and is being made ready for occupancy by his family, has been painted gray."
