

Questions & Answers About Our Environment

Dear EarthTalk: Is it true that you shouldn't put plastic bottle caps that are less than three inches wide in diameter into the recycling bin?
 -- Bill S., Grafton, VT

Yes! It is true that you shouldn't recycle plastic bottle caps that are less than three inches in diameter; in fact, you shouldn't recycle anything that is less than three inches in diameter.

Why is this? During the recycling process, plastics are sorted, baled, washed, ground down, separated from contaminants, melted, filtered and made into pellets. This is a long, complicated process, and the smallest plastics are often easily lost. The end result is an overaccumulation of plastic bottle lids and other small plastic items that were disposed of improperly and unfortunately have nowhere to go.

This overaccumulation is very problematic for animal life; marine life in particular. Hawaii, for example, is detrimentally affected by the global plastics issue. Because of its location in the Pacific, much of the world's plastic waste ends up on Hawaii's beaches, making the 50th state an unfortunate but necessary target of scientific inquiry. According to the Beach Environmental Awareness Campaign Hawaii (BEACH), plastic caps are among the top 10 items found during beach clean-ups. In another study completed by BEACH, it was found that 100 per cent of albatross chicks that call the northwestern Hawaiian Islands home had eaten plastic derived from a number of sources, plastic bottle caps being one of them.

Unfortunately, most plastic bottle caps, regardless of their size, are not easily recycled and may require a specialized facility. According to Earth 911, plastic bottle caps are made from a different kind of plastic called polypropylene (plastic #5) which has a higher melting point (a difference of 160 degrees Fahrenheit!). Because of this, when the plastic recyclables are melted down, the bottle caps stay intact. This can render an entire batch of recyclables useless, which means it becomes unusable waste again.

Thankfully, specialized recycling facilities circumnavigate this issue by grinding the plastic caps into flakes. These flakes are then melted into pellets, which are formed into new items such as reusable plastic bags or car battery casings.

However, finding these specialized facilities may be a bit tricky, depending on where you live. Most curbside collectors offer a cap-on standard, whereby you as the recycler may recycle plastic caps if they are twisted onto a bottle. However, some do not as they may consider a sealed bottle a safety hazard (due to compression/explosion) while others may simply want to avoid liquids. In some select cases, they may refuse to recycle bottle caps simply because the financial return rate is too low. Whatever the case, it is advised that you determine exactly what options your recycling program offers, as the options do vary.

If you're having difficulty finding a convenient way to recycle your plastic bottle caps, your best option would be to

either save them up and then throw them out at an acceptable facility, or to reuse them. Many plastic caps are actually universal and can be used on all sorts of different plastic bottles. Other more determined recyclers have even gone as far as to make arts and crafts from bottle caps!





- nonstick cooking spray
- 4 tablespoons unsalted butter (1/2 stick), at room temperature
- maple syrup, to taste

In large bowl, whisk flour, salt, cinnamon, baking powder and brown sugar. In smaller bowl, whisk eggs, milk and melted butter.

Make well in dry ingredients then mix in wet ingredient mixture until just combined.

Using cheese grater, grate apple. Fold grated apple into batter.

Prepare waffle iron with nonstick cooking spray.

Ladle 1/4 of batter mixture into waffle iron and cook according to manufacturer’s instructions. Repeat with remaining batter.

Top each waffle with 1 tablespoon room temperature butter and maple syrup, to taste.

Senate panel, House approve bills to improve accountability for emergency powers

State Rep. Julie Alexander and the Michigan House of Representatives on Wednesday approved a detailed plan to bring greater accountability and transparency to Michigan's emergency powers.

The House vote on 23 bills followed the Senate Oversight Committee's morning approval of seven other bills that passed the House earlier this year. Alexander and other legislators put forward the comprehensive plan to ensure accountability for broad authority used by the governor and state agencies to address emergencies. The plan would set timeframes, strengthen oversight by the Legislature, eliminate redundant laws, and remove unnecessary powers.

"With this plan, legislators are doing our job to serve and represent the people of Michigan," said Alexander, R-Hanover. "We are revisiting laws on the books and revising them to better serve the citizens."

"Our plan will bring our emergency laws more in line with the people by promoting transparency for emergency powers, defining timeframes for emergency authority, and

updating our laws to remove unneeded powers. While using emergency powers to meet the urgent needs of the moment, public servants must stay thoroughly accountable."

The overall plan would increase accountability by:

Setting reasonable timeframes: Some bills within the package would provide a specific role for elected legislators in the exercise of emergency powers, by ending the application of certain authority after 28 days, requiring the Michigan Legislature to decide whether to extend the power in that instance. The Senate panel on Wednesday approved Alexander's House Bill 6184, which would set a time limit and allow legislative reauthorization for epidemic orders issued by the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services, which were used quite broadly regarding COVID-19.

Ensuring transparency: In order to ensure lawmakers overseeing state departments are aware of the use of emergency authority, other bills would require the executive branch to notify the Legislature in a timely manner — typically

24 hours — after some powers are exercised. Alexander's House Bill 6199, which passed the House on Wednesday, would require legislative notification within 24 hours after the Michigan Department of Agriculture and Rural Development issues a notice to deal with dangerous insects or diseases affecting plants.

Cleaning up the law: Additional bills in the package would repeal unnecessary or outdated emergency powers, some of which have rarely or never been used. Other statutes to be repealed are redundant, granting power also authorized elsewhere in Michigan law.

Many of the bills received bipartisan support in the House. The entire 30-bill package is now in the Senate.



Senior Spotlight

What your feet can tell you about your health understanding peripheral artery disease



(Family Features) If you are living with pain and discomfort in your feet, legs, thighs or butt, it may be a sign of a serious health problem. Many adults in the United States are suffering and may be at risk of amputations of their toes, feet or legs as a result of an undetected disease known as peripheral artery disease (PAD).

PAD affects the blood vessels outside the heart, reducing blood flow to the area with the

diseased blood vessel. In the most common type of PAD, lower extremity PAD, blood flow is reduced to your legs and feet.

Learning more about PAD is important for detecting problems and getting early treatment so you can avoid devastating complications such as amputation or even death. Learn more about PAD, including symptoms, risk factors and treatment, from the experts at the American

Heart Association:

Symptoms

The most common symptoms of PAD are burning, aching, numbness, fatigue or discomfort in your leg or hip muscles while walking. The symptoms are caused by your legs not getting the blood they need. This pain usually goes away with rest and returns when you are active again.

"These symptoms can impact a person's quality of life, making it difficult to walk and hard to do usual activities at home and work," said Amy W. Pollak, MD, American Heart Association volunteer expert serving as a leader of the national PAD Collaborative and cardiovascular medicine physician at Mayo Clinic. "For some, PAD can progress to cause pain when you are resting and even amputation of your toe, foot or leg."

Risk Factors

PAD affects more than 8.5 million people in the U.S., the majority of whom are 65 years and older, according to the American Heart Association. Approximately 46-68% of patients with PAD also have coronary artery disease or cerebrovascular disease.

"We see PAD more commonly in people living with diabetes, people who smoke and people with other common risk factors for heart disease, like high cholesterol, high blood pressure and obesity," Pollak said.

Prevention and Treatment

While some causes of PAD are beyond your control, the best method to prevent PAD is managing risk factors by making lifestyle changes including quitting smoking, managing diabetes and high blood pressure, staying active and eating a heart-healthy diet.

Working closely with your health care professional at the first sign of PAD is an important step in achieving the best treatment outcomes and avoiding serious complications like amputation.

"PAD is a lifelong medical condition, but people with PAD can lead active and long

lives," Pollak said. "If you notice walking is more difficult, keeping up with others is hard or you have pain when you walk, talk with a doctor and describe when it happens and how it feels. Don't be afraid to get a second opinion."
