





AG Nessel reissues consumer alert following new T-Mobile data breach

LANSING – Michigan Attorney General Dana Nessel is reissuing a consumer alert that provides information on responding to a data breach after T-Mobile confirmed the company suffered a breach that happened between Nov. 25, 2022 and Jan. 5, 2023. It may have exposed information including names, billing addresses, email addresses, telephone numbers, dates of birth, T-Mobile account number, number of lines on the account and service plan features. T-Mobile believes that no passwords, payment card information, social security numbers or other financial account infor-

mation was accessed. The impact of this breach is currently undetermined.

Consumers should remain vigilant for suspicious emails, texts, or phone calls in the wake of this data breach.

Consumers have the right to order a free credit report from each of the three major credit reporting companies every year through the following:

- by mail—complete the annual credit report request form and send to the listed address;
- by telephone—call 877-322-8228 (toll free); or
- online—annualcreditreport.com, is the only truly free credit report website. Other ways to respond to a data breach explained in the alert include:

1. Put a fraud alert on your credit file: A fraud alert is a free alert, or flag, that is placed on your credit file when you notify a credit reporting agency that your information may have been compromised. This alert will make it more difficult for anyone to open an account in your name.

2. Consider a security freeze on your credit file: A security freeze or credit freeze is something you request from a credit reporting agency to restrict access to your credit report. This makes it more difficult for identity thieves to open new accounts in your name because most creditors will demand to see your credit report before they approve new credit. If a creditor cannot see your file, then the creditor should not extend the credit. A credit freeze does not prevent all third parties from seeing your report.

3. Credit monitoring: a service that tracks your credit report and alerts you whenever a change is made. This gives you the opportunity to confirm the accuracy of the change and, if needed, contest any inaccuracy. The specifics of any service will depend on the provider; however, most advertise they will notify you within 24 hours of any change.

4. Take advantage of any free services being offered as a result of the breach: Before you accept a free subscription offered as a result of a security breach, carefully consider any conditions placed on your acceptance of it. For example, will

you be charged after a short free period, or will you only get it if you give up your right to additional legal redress?

5. Use two-factor authentication: it requires both your password and another piece of information to log in to your account. The second piece could be a code sent to your phone, or a random number generated by an app or a token (a physical object in user's possession). This protects your account even if your password is compromised.

Senior Spotlight

Ensuring good nutrition and better health of children and caregivers



(StatePoint) There are 2.5 million children in the United States growing up in "grandfamilies," meaning they're being raised by relatives or close friends without their parents in the home, and they face higher rates of hunger and food insecurity, according to a new report.

The Generations United report, "Together at the Table: Supporting the Nutrition, Health and Well-Being of Grandfamilies," highlights the particular struggles of such households, which are often unprepared financially for the unexpected job of raising a child, and may encounter difficulty accessing food and nutrition programs designed to help.

In fact, 25% of grandparent-headed households experienced food insecurity between 2019 and 2020, which is more than twice the national rate. The long-term health implications of food insecurity -- including diabetes, hypertension, heart disease, obesity and eating disorders -- are dire. Additionally, food

insecurity negatively affects a child's ability to learn and

grow. While families from all ar-

reas of the country face food insecurity, for the large number of grandfamilies living in the South and in rural areas, services are often more limited or challenging to access. What's more, grandfamilies are disproportionately Black, Latino and American Indian and Alaska Native, populations that already have disproportionate rates of food insecurity due to years of systemic racism.

Recently, the White House released a sweeping national strategy to reduce hunger. While advocates describe the plan as welcome and comprehensive on many levels, and say that it identifies the importance of improved outreach to grandfamilies, they also believe it must go further. According to Generations United, some key policy changes to reduce food insecurity for grandfamilies include:

- Developing quality kinship navigator programs that

connect grandfamilies to support and services in their communities. These programs should provide food and nutrition support to grandfamilies outside the child welfare system.

- Expanding access to the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) by making a "child-only" benefit that is based on the needs of the child as opposed to household income and by increasing outreach to grandfamilies.

- Ensuring automatic access to free and reduced school meals for children living in grandfamilies.

- Improving outreach of the Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) to help reach more grandfamilies and connect them with benefits for which they are eligible.

- Creating joint meal pro-

grams for grandfamily caregivers and the children they raise.

"Research shows that being raised by family members or close friends is the best option for children who can't be raised by their parents," said Donna Butts, the executive director of Generations United. "But unfortunately, these families face hunger and food insecurity at much higher rates than the average family. The need for basic nutrition and adequate food is universal, and every family deserves to be healthy and thrive. The fact that many of our policies and programs to reduce hunger were not designed with grandfamilies in mind should not stand in the way of this right."

Tex-Mex Beef Lasagna

Total time: 60 minutes
Servings: 10

- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1 onion, diced
- 2 pounds ground beef
- 2 teaspoons kosher salt
- 1 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1/2 teaspoon cumin
- 2 teaspoons chipotle powder

- 1/2 teaspoon onion powder
- 15 ounces canned corn, drained
- 15 ounces canned seasoned black beans, drained
- 10 ounces canned diced tomatoes with green chiles, drained
- 15 ounces canned red enchilada sauce
- 1 cup Mexican crema or sour cream
- nonstick cooking spray
- 12 corn tortillas
- 8 ounces shredded Mexican blend cheese
- cilantro (optional)
- green onions, thinly sliced (optional)

Preheat oven to 375 F.

In large pan or skillet, heat olive oil over medium-high heat then add onion. Cook until softened, 4-5 minutes, stirring regularly.

Add ground beef and cook, stirring regularly, until beef has browned.

Add kosher salt, garlic powder, cumin, chipotle



powder and onion powder; stir well. Add corn, black beans and diced tomatoes. Turn heat to medium and simmer 10 minutes. Remove from heat.

In bowl, combine enchilada sauce and crema; mix well.

Spray casserole dish with nonstick cooking spray. Pour about 1/4 cup enchilada sauce mixture on bottom to prevent tortillas from

sticking.

Layer 2-4 tortillas across bottom then top with layer of ground beef mixture. Use ladle to spoon some enchilada sauce mixture on top, distributing evenly. Top with another layer of tortillas then repeat layers until casserole is full, 3-4 layers. Top with shredded cheese.

Loosely cover dish with foil in tent shape to help prevent cheese

from sticking then bake 30 minutes.

Remove foil and bake 10-15 minutes until cheese is bubbly and golden brown.

Cool 5 minutes before serving. Top with cilantro and green onions, if desired.

HISTORICAL NOTEBOOK

by Frank Passic
Albion Historian



ALBION 100 YEARS AGO —FEBRUARY 1923

We continue with our theme of, "Albion 100 Years Ago." February 1, 1923: "The mine operated by the People's Coal Mining Company located three miles north of the city entertained lady visitors last Saturday for the first time in its history."

"Mark Donovan, Herbert

Stinekrauss and Donald Boyd returned yesterday from Detroit with three new Ford cars for the Albion Motor Sales Company." "Mrs. Louie Hartung is confined to her home on S. Ionia St. with the grip." "Miss Dellamae Smith is ill with the grip at her home on Walnut St." "Nelson Jessup,

member of the city fire department, is ill with the grip at his home on E. Mulberry St." "Donald Hubbard of the Hubert Flower store, has been confined to his home on Jackson Road for several days. He is having a visitation of the grip."

February 3, 1923: "The former grocery business of Frank E. Clark, at 113 S. Superior St., was sold today by W. E. Baum and company to John Carthy, who has been employed by that concern."

"Dr. Charles M. Guyselman and George Bogue Hunt, former Albionites who are now residents of Jackson, are among the leaders in a movement to attempt to prevent the Jackson board of education

from compelling school children to be vaccinated and also to do away with the physical examination of pupils of the school system of that city."

February 6, 1923: A member of the family of A. L. Preston, 606 Fitch St., has broken out with smallpox and the house is quarantined. This is the second case to be quarantined in Albion, both being on Fitch St. The disease, according to a local physician, was brought here by a woman who came to Albion from Butler, Indiana, where there is an epidemic at the present time."

February 10, 1923. "Preston Perdue, colored man living at 1238 Highland Ave., was sitting in his home quietly reading the bible to members of his family last evening about 7:15, when two revolver shots were heard suddenly, fired through the south window of the home, one of them inflicting a flesh wound in Perdue's left shoulder and the other spending itself in the window sash."

February 13, 1923. "Edward, the 7-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Leslie Quigg, Edwards St., who recently had pneumonia and spinal meningitis, is now able to walk about the house. He was treated by spinal puncture and introduction of antimeningococcle [Note: That is how that word was spelled and printed in the article] serum, a rather recent discovery."

February 16, 1923. "The contract for the erection of a new factory building is to be located just west of the city water works on Albion St for the Service Caster and Truck Company, which concern will move here in April from Kansas City, Missouri, was let today by the Albion Realty Company to Perry Sharp, Albion contractor."

February 20, 1923. Bids were let by the City Coun-

cil for the construction of the new \$100k James Wadsworth Sheldon Memorial Hospital by this city. The Schumacher Construction Company had the lowest bid and was awarded the contract."

February 26, 1923. "Fourteen persons were arrested, including three colored women, eight colored men, and three white men, as the result of raids made late Saturday night and early Sunday morning by local officers on gambling and disorderly places in the northwest part of the city."

February 28, 1923. "An important change in local business circles was announced today by which D.F. Wickens takes over the Albion agency for the Dodge motor car and the garage at the corner of Michigan Avenue and Ionia St. from Louis F. Striker, who has conducted the business at that stand for the past seven years, establishing it in 1916."


