

EARTH TALK

Questions & Answers About Our Environment

Dear EarthTalk: Which of the EV models now available in the U.S. provide the most bang for the buck? Is now a good time to finally make the upgrade from my internal combustion car?

-- P. Bronson, Tampa, FL

With some 43 new battery-powered electric vehicles (EVs) debuting in the U.S. this 2023 model year, not to mention the continued production and sales of 32 previous EV models, there has never been a better time to make the switch from your internal combustion gas guzzler to something greener. The increased competition among carmakers for your EV dollars means lower prices all around; indeed 14 different EVs sport sticker prices of \$40,000 or below.

Cheapest of them all is still the Nissan Leaf, with a manufacturer's suggested retail price (MSRP) of \$27,400. While this is the only EV for sale in the U.S. with a sticker price under \$30k, the trade-off is less range; the Leaf will only get you about 149 miles per full charge, making it perfect for short commutes or jaunts around town but not so good for road trips. (Nissan also offers a Leaf "Plus" model with a bigger battery array that sells for \$5,000 more but gets you

226 miles between charges.)

The next cheapest EV is Chevrolet's Bolt, with a sticker price of \$31,500 and a range of 259 miles; given this longer range, this little hatchback by one of America's great carmakers might just be the best bang-for-buck option out there. Chevy is also offering a Bolt EUV model which gives customers a roomier interior for \$2,000 more than the base Bolt, but with slight range trade-off (247 miles between charges).

Other good options for cost-conscious EV buyers include Hyundai's Kona Electric (\$34,000; 258-mile range), Subaru's Solterra SUV (\$37,000; 285-mile range), Kia's Niro EV (\$39,990; 239-mile range). Also under \$40k but with less range include Hyundai's Ioniq Electric sedan (\$33,245; 170-mile range), Mazda's MX30 crossover (\$33,470; 100-mile range), and Mini Cooper's EV (\$33,900; 114 mile range).

Of course, these MSRPs don't factor in tax rebates and other financial incentives. In the U.S., EV buyers still qualify for up to \$7,500 in tax credits. The amount varies depending on your tax bracket and other factors including where the vehicle in question was built. Some state governments and municipalities offer their own incentives for EV buyers. Get the full run down for your location via the Database of State Incentives for Renewables & Efficiency (DSIRE), a free and comprehensive resource on federal, state and regional incentives supporting renewables and energy efficiency across the U.S.

February is Heart Health Month

JACKSON COUNTY, MI – Heart disease is a leading cause of hospitalizations and deaths in Jackson. Statistics from 2019-2021 show an average of 588 Jackson County residents pass away from heart disease each year. February is National Heart Health Month and is a great time to educate yourself on heart disease, its risk factors, impacts on health, and methods of prevention.

A nutritious diet, regular exercise, a healthy weight, adequate sleep, and limiting smoking and alcohol intake can help prevent heart disease. During National Heart Health month, Jackson County Health Department would like to highlight the importance of fiber intake in the diet. Fiber is the portion of plant-derived foods that cannot be completely broken down by the body. Fruits and vegetables, whole grains, legumes, nuts, and

seeds are high in fiber. Dietary fiber has several heart and digestive health benefits. There are two main functions of fiber. First, intake of fiber can help with weight control due to its ability to help one feel full for a longer period of time, which may reduce overall calorie intake. Second, fiber when ingested will bind to the LDL 'bad' cholesterol in the body so that it cannot be absorbed, which reduces cholesterol levels. Adults should eat between 25-30g of fiber daily; most people fall short of this. Some of the highest-fiber foods are pears with skin on, fresh berries, avocado, brussel sprouts, lentils, kidney beans, oatmeal, popcorn, almonds, ground flaxseed, or chia seed. If your diet tends to include these foods, you are probably doing a good job with fiber intake. If you think your digestion is struggling, you could benefit

from increasing your intake of these foods to help keep your heart healthy. To learn more about dietary fiber or to look up how much fiber a certain food contains, visit Fiber | Nutrition.gov.

A healthy diet starts with being able to access healthy food. Jackson families with children under the age of five, and individuals that are pregnant, are invited to reach out to the Jackson County Health Department Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) office.

Over 60% of families in Jackson are eligible for WIC benefits. WIC benefits can be used to purchase fresh fruit, veggies, and formula. In addition, WIC provides access to a dietitian or knowledgeable staff member to help create nutritional plans for you and your children.

HISTORICAL NOTEBOOK

WATER WORKS BUILDING

At 119 E. Cass St. sits an old brick building that sits a way back from the street, which once had a prominent significance in our community. This is the Albion Water Works building, erected around 1889 to provide water to our community. Albion's municipal water system was instituted beginning in 1889 as a result of two \$50,000 municipal bond issues that passed. The water was supplied from two six-inch wells at the site, 162 feet deep. The 1893 Sanborn map stated described the site and water system at that time: "2 Hughes pumps, combined cap, 8 million gallons per 24 hours, 8 3/4 miles pipes laid in all. Stand pipe 134 feet height, 12 feet diameter." The Water Works building operated on steam heat pro-


vided by coal, and a coal bin once stood behind the brick structure. In 1906 the plant switched to a single-stage electric pump, and in 1909, to a two-stage electric pump. A round reservoir holding tank that contained approximately 80,000 gallons of water was constructed in front of the pump house, where the actual wells were located, according to the Sanborn map. When erecting a replacement concrete-enforced reservoir in 1909, it was discovered that the casings to the two original wells had deteriorated to the point where they had to be plugged. The new reservoir held 250,000 gallons of water. Three new 8-inch wells were thereby drilled, 100 feet deep to supply the city with its water. By 1912 a few years

later, the city was pumping an average of 13 to 19 million gallons a month from this site.

The water pressure and volume were supplied by the standpipe that was constructed in 1889 on the highest point in town, today's Crowell Park, next to where today's water tower sits today. This provided water pressure of 80 pounds to the square inch.

As Albion expanded and grew, the city erected a new pumping station which opened in 1916 on N. Albion St. The E. Cass St. location was then used as a back-up well in case of failures. The standpipe in Crowell Park was toppled on February 26, 1962, upon the completion of a new water tower that is still there today. The reservoir tank in front of the Water Works building was demolished on November 8, 1961.

The Albion Water Works building became the home of the Albion Recycling Center from the 1970s into the 1990s. It was operated by Truman Barnes and a host of community volunteers. Today the building still stands, and is



now privately owned.


