# Senior Spotlight

## Managing heart attack treatment and follow-up care

(Family Features) As the proportion of older adults in the U.S. continues to increase, appropriate care for older people becomes increasingly important. In fact, caregivers and loved ones should be aware of age-appropriate care for heart attack or chest pain.

The first step is to call 911. Once medical care is started, age-related changes in general health and in the heart and blood vessels require consideration, and likely modifications, in how people age 75 and older are treated, according to a scientific statement from the American Heart Association, published in its flagship, peer-reviewed journal "Circulation."

The statement, "Management of acute coronary syndrome (ACS) in the older adult population," highlights evidence to help clinicians better care for older patients. According to the statement, 30-40% of people hospitalized with ACS, which includes heart attack and unstable angina (heart-related chest pain), are age 75 or older.

"Older patients have more pronounced anatomical changes and more severe functional impairment, and they are more likely to have additional health conditions not related to heart disease," said Abdulla A. Damluji, M.D., Ph.D., FAHA, chair of the scientific statement writing committee, director of the Inova Center of Outcomes Research, and an associate professor of medicine at Johns Hopkins

School of Medicine. "These include frailty, other chronic disorders (treated with multiple medications), physical dysfunction, cognitive decline or urinary incontinence."

Normal Aging and Age-Related Changes in the Heart and Blood Vessels

Cardiovascular changes that occur with normal aging make ACS more likely and may make diagnosing and treating it more complex. These changes include large arteries becoming stiffer, the heart working harder but pumping less effectively, blood vessels becoming less flexible and less able to respond to changes in the heart's oxygen needs and an increased tendency to form blood clots. Sensory decline due to aging may alter hearing, vision and pain sensations. Kidney function also declines with age, with more than 1/3 of people ages 65 and older having chronic kidney disease.

Multiple Medical Conditions and Medications

As people age, they are often diagnosed with health conditions that may be worsened by ACS or complicate existing ACS. As these chronic conditions are treated, medications prescribed may result in unwanted interactions or medications that treat one condition may worsen another.

"Geriatric syndromes and the complexities of their care may undermine the effectiveness of treatments for ACS, as well as the resiliency of older adults to survive and recover," Dam-

luji said. "A detailed review of all medications - including supplements and over-the-counter medicines - is essential, ideally in consultation with a pharmacist who has geriatric expertise."

Steps for Heart Attack Care and Follow-Up for Older Adults

\* Call 911 if you notice someone experiencing heart attack warning signs. These include chest discomfort, discomfort in other areas of the upper body (one or both arms, back, neck, jaw or stomach), shortness of breath or other symptoms such as a cold sweat, nausea or lightheadedness.

\* Consider treatment needs for co-existing conditions. An individualized, patient-centered approach is best for older adults.

\* Get input from multiple specialists, including a pharmacist, to manage care and medications.

\* People with cognitive difficulties and limited mobility may benefit from a simplified medication schedule, with fewer doses per day and 90-day supplies of medications so fewer refills are necessary.

\* The goals of care for older people with ACS should extend beyond clinical outcomes and focus on quality of life and the ability to live independently.

\* Do-not-resuscitate orders should be discussed before any surgery or procedure.

## Savory Cheese Balls

- Servings: 6-12*  
 2 packages (8 ounces each) cream cheese  
 2 tablespoons caraway seeds  
 1 teaspoon poppy seeds  
 2 cloves garlic, minced, divided  
 1/4 cup parsley, chopped  
 2 teaspoons thyme leaves, chopped  
 1 teaspoon rosemary, chopped  
 1/4 cup dried cranberries, chopped  
 2 tablespoons pecans, chopped  
 crackers (optional)  
 fruit (optional)

vegetables (optional)

Cut each cream cheese block into three squares. Roll each square into ball.

In small bowl, combine caraway seeds, poppy seeds and half the garlic.

In second small bowl, combine parsley, thyme, rosemary and remaining garlic.

In third small bowl, combine cranberries and pecans.

Roll two cheese balls in seed mixture, two in herb mixture and two in cranberry mixture.

**Whipped Cream:**  
 2 cups heavy whipping cream, cold  
 2 tablespoons Domino Golden Sugar  
 2 teaspoons pure vanilla extract  
**Trifle:**  
 1 cup blueberry jam  
 12 ounces fresh blueberries, plus additional for garnish, divided  
 1 pound cake, cubed  
 lemon slices, for garnish  
 mint, for garnish

To make lemon curd: In medium saucepan, stir sugar and cornstarch. Stir in lemon juice, lemon zest, water and salt. Cook over medium heat, stirring constantly, until thickened. Remove from heat and gradually stir in three egg yolks; mix well until combined. Stir in remaining egg yolks. Return to heat and cook 2 minutes, stirring constantly. Remove from heat.

Stir in butter; mix until incorporated. Cover with plastic wrap, touching surface of lemon curd to prevent curd forming skin. Refrigerate until completely cool.

To make whipped cream: In large bowl, beat cream, sugar and vanilla until soft peaks form. Do not overbeat.

To make trifle: Mix blueberry jam with 12 ounces fresh blueberries. Place one layer cubed pound cake in bottom of trifle dish. Top with layer of blueberries. Add dollops of lemon curd and whipped cream. Repeat layering ending with whipped cream.

 1 1/2 cups shredded cheese, divided  
 2 frozen deep dish pie shells (9 inches each)  
 Heat oven to 350 F.  
 In medium bowl, add broccoli and cheese contents from package. Microwave 5 minutes, or until cheese is saucy. Set

aside.

In skillet, cook chopped bacon 4 minutes. Add green onions; cook 2 minutes. Add mushrooms; cook 4 minutes, or until bacon is completely cooked and mushrooms are tender. Drain onto paper towel over plate. Set aside.

In medium bowl, whisk eggs and milk until combined. Add broccoli and cheese mixture. Add 1 cup cheese. Stir to combine. Set aside.

In pie shells, divide drained bacon mixture evenly. Divide broccoli mixture evenly and pour over bacon mixture. Sprinkle remaining cheese over both pies.

Bake 40 minutes. Cool at least 12 minutes before serving.

Note: To keep edges of crust from burning, place aluminum foil over pies for first 20 minutes of cook time. Remove after 20 minutes and allow to cook uncovered until completed.



# HISTORICAL NOTEBOOK

the Wochholz & Deyoe Grocery, the Wochholz & Baader cigar manufacturers, the Wochholz clothing store, the Wochholz Brothers Saloon, and John Wochholz tavern. The latter's establishment was called The Midway, and was located a 309 S. Superior St. If you have a hard time spelling the family surname, remember, it contains TWO "h's," and only ONE "c." It's easy to spell when you remember that.

The 1897 Albion Directory lists John as a molder at the Gale Manufacturing Company. He was only in the tavern business beginning around 1906 to around 1910. A 1907 advertisement states "The Midway, John Wochholz, Pro-



prietor. Wines, liquors, Cigars. Telephone No. 436. 309 S. Superior St." John sold his business to Herman Stark who continued to operate it in the early 1910s. Stark subsequently added a partner, Frank Reichow, who eventually purchased and ran the business at that site until Prohibition was instituted locally.

John Wochholz subsequently took up selling life insurance for the Michigan State Life Insurance Company. He



died suddenly on March 11, 1925 of a heart attack while turning on water to take a bath. He was buried in Riverside Cemetery.

There are two collectible items to remember John Wochholz by. The first is a beverage bottle, made of thick, clear glass. The bottom of the bottle has a diameter of about 3 1/4 inches, and the bottle is just a little over 11 1/2 inches tall. The raised glass lettering at the bottom of the bottle reads,



"JOHN WOCHHOLZ ALBION, MICH." No other markings are found anywhere else on the bottle. The second item is an aluminum token which reads, "J.W. ALBION MICH on the obverse, and "GOOD FOR 5c IN TRADE."

From our Historical Notebook this week we present a photo of the bottom of the bottle, and the John Wochholz token. How many of our readers have such collectible items from Albion's history?

Dear EarthTalk: Google has a huge amount of influence around the world. What are they doing to promote sustainability that drives real change?

 Google's stance on sustainability has always been positive, so much so that it has become an integral part of who they are as a company. As is stated on their official site page on sustainability, "We unify

our practices, partnerships, and products around a single mission—to foster sustainability at scale." Google has adopted a number of changes to the way their search engine works, changes that put sustainability at the forefront of the average Google-user's mind.  
 Some of these new features include an automatic carbon footprint analyzer that chooses the greenest options for you, be it flights, hotels, driving routes or appliances. Incredibly, the analyzer is so advanced that it gathers information pertaining to a particular flight's carbon output per seat; a hotel's green practices and whether or not they are Green Key or Earth-Check Certified; the greenest and most cost-effective routes to drive; and even the cost-effectiveness and sustainability

ratings of appliances.  
 Now, all these features and services are great for the user, but what about big-picture sustainability?  
 At their Google Cloud Sustainability Summit, which occurred near the end of June 2022, Google announced that they would be launching a sustainability platform for their customers to use to boost their own sustainability initiatives. The platform would grant users access to the Google Earth Engine, a tool previously only accessible by scientists and nonprofit organizations. The aim is to give customers the ability to extrapolate how their company's actions affect not only their marketplace, but the world around them.  
 Furthermore, Google has been using their research into

artificial intelligence to optimize the efficiency of traffic lights. The research, which was piloted in Israel, managed to predict traffic conditions and improve traffic light timing so well that they saw a 10 to 20 per cent reduction in fuel consumption and intersection delay time. In the future, they hope to expand this operation into Rio de Janeiro, and hopefully further, should it continue to see success.  
 While Google has accomplished a great deal in their quest for a more sustainable future, their use of wording may be slightly misleading for some, in particular, their use of the term "carbon-neutral," especially as it pertains to one of their greatest achievements: Carbon Neutrality since 2007.  
 What most people don't re-

alize is that carbon neutrality doesn't mean that the company in question produces no carbon, or that they remove the carbon they produced from the atmosphere; it means they are offsetting their carbon output by investing in green initiatives, purchasing green energy and taking other actions that purportedly reduce other carbon outputs by as much as 20 million tons!
